## winter trail damage



- Due to recent rains, some LARGE rocks have fallen on the trail near Floriston along with deep sticky mud. It is impassable. Also up in the California Canyon, Fleish Road is still closed and will remain so until late April.
- Happily, the trail near Farad is in reasonably good shape.
- Other areas with debris and/or floodwater are the south end of the Rez, near Wadsworth, and Nature Conservancy lands from Mustang to Tracy.

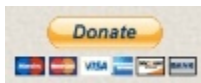
We always can use more eyes and ears! Please call or email us about any damage you see.
